# **Online enrolment**

Procedures and deadlines for enrolment depends on where you come from:

**EU students and equivalent** are citizens from European Member States and from Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Swiss Confederation, Republic of San Marino, Holy See and citizens of non-EU countries already officially residing in Italy (i.e. holding a permit of stay valid for enrolment).

• Non-EU students who require a visa are citizens of non-European countries who require a visa for long-term stay in Italy valid for enrolment.

Why are there different procedures based on nationality? Lately, procedures for visa issuance for non-EU citizens have been completely revised by the Ministry and all deadlines have been postponed.

For this reason, Ca' Foscari decided to postpone deadlines for enrolment to give non-EU students the due time to obtain their visa and complete the subsequent steps.

# Open access and limited access: what's the difference

- Open-access: admission through an assessment of curricular requirements and personal preparation. You have received your letter of enrolment eligibility <u>without</u> participating in a selection procedure.
- **Limited-access**: admission through an assessment of curricular requirements and a selection procedure. You have taken an entry test in order to be eligible for enrolment. There are different calls for applications based on the nationality:
  - o **EU students and equivalent** follow the call published on <u>www.unive.it</u>
  - Non-EU students requiring a visa have already followed the calls published on <u>apply.unive.it</u>

- (for non-EU students) Italian visa for study.
- (for non-EU students residing in Italy) Italian residence permit valid for enrolment.

#### Master's degree programmes

- Bachelor's degree final Diploma and transcript of records;
- Statement of comparability issued by CIMEA
   or Declaration of Value issued by Italian Diplomatic or
   Consular representatives based in the country where
   your entry qualification was obtained
   or ARDI Statement of Correspondance along with the
   CIMEA Statement of Verification.

- Language certificates;

# **Tuition fees**

#### **EU students and equivalent**

Three instalments for 2024/25 academic year:

- 1. see deadlines for enrolment (slide 5)
- to be paid by 10 December 2024
- 3. to be paid by 16 May 2025

#### Non-EU students who require a visa

Three instalments for 2024/25 academic year:

- 1. to be paid by 17 December 2024
- 2. to be paid by 10 December 2024 (if you pay the first instalment after December 10th, this instalment will be postponed to 23 December 2024)
- 3. to be paid by 16 May 2024

#### **Tuition Fee Waiver and CRUI/MAECI scholarship**

If you have already obtained your visa (if relevant) will be required to pay only:

- €184 (Regional fee)
- €16 (revenue stamp)





# **Enrolment procedure**

**EU students and equivalent for limited-access programmes only** 

European students and equivalent with the "Entry test Europeans/equivalent" status on apply.unive.it and enrolling in limited-access degree programmes must follow the <u>procedures</u> and deadlines for enrolment described in the relevant call for applications on www.unive.it!

\*\*\*ALL OTHERS: ACCEPTED AND CONDITIONALLY ACCEPTED\*\*\*

All students who do not belong to the above-mentioned category will follow the procedure described in the following slides.

# **Provisional login information**

- Automatic import: personal information of students who have been accepted or conditionally accepted on apply.unive.it are imported automatically into Ca' Foscari's database.
- Instructions for activating the unive.it account: applicants receive an email with instructions on how to activate the account and obtain the provisional credentials.
- Login details what to do with them: the provisional username and password can be used to access the Personal Area for pay the tuition fees; access <u>digital learning tools</u> once classes start; apply for the <u>Regional scholarship for student financial aid</u>.


The provisional credentials will be replaced by your *matricola* number and password once you are enrolled.





# Decide the programme you wish to enrol in

After receiving your provisional credentials, you are required to **confirm the degree programme you wish to enrol in** on our **application portal apply.unive.it**, through the so-called "**Decision**" function.

- a. Access your online application on apply.unive.it;
- b. Click on "Offers" > "Review your offers";
- c. Click on the drop-down menu to make the decision;
- d. Click on "Make my final decision" to confirm the programme, the system will automatically decline all other possible offers.

#### **IMPORTANT!**


- you need to formally make a decision, even if you have been accepted or conditionally accepted for one programme only.
- if you are a non-EU student requiring a visa for enrolment, you must confirm the choice you made in your pre-enrolment application on Universitaly.



## **Enrolment request**

- An enrolment request for the programme you chose will <u>automatically</u> be generated in our system, when the final decision has been made.
- Within 2-3 days you will receive an email confirming that the enrolment request has been successfully generated and
  giving instructions on how to carry out the payment to confirm and submit your enrolment request.

IMPORTANT: YOU DO NOT NEED TO DO ANYTHING AFTER THE DECISION!

Just wait for further instructions.

## **Payment**

- In order to confirm and submit your enrolment request, you must pay the first installment of annual fees.
- Make sure to follow the deadlines for payments mentioned above.

### **Enrolment finalization**

- The Welcome Unit will **verify your enrollment application** and will finalize the request as soon as possible, provided that **you meet all requirements** and **hold all mandatory documents**.
- You will then receive an email containing **your matriculation number** (*matricola*) **and password**. These credentials will replace the provisional ones and grant access to your Personal Area and webmail @stud.unive.it.
- Remember that **your email address @stud.unive.it** will be used for all official communications: make sure to **check it regularly**.
