

Summer School – Italian History and Culture 18 – 29 July 2017

Dear students,

With this document we hope to give you some idea of your stay in Venice this summer as guests of the Ca' Foscari School for International Education.

Where will I be staying?

Your dorm (the Residenza We_Crociferi) is in the area of Cannaregio (Campo ai Gesuiti). The residence is brand new and has been constructed through the renovation of an ancient building adjacent to the church of the Gesuiti. The residence is surrounded by residential properties so your cooperation is requested for harmonious community living.

Your rooms have been reserved from July 17th until July 23rd. You will be sleeping in double rooms.

What facilities does it have?


All rooms have air conditioning. The residence will provide you with sheets and towels, so there is no need to bring those. Be aware, however, that if you wish to go to the beach, you cannot use the towels provided by the residence for that purpose and you should bring your own beach towel (or, buy one once in Venice).

Breakfast is provided. Students have the opportunity to shop at the local markets and frequent the restaurants and bars in their neighborhood.

There will be internet access, but no computers, so bring your own device. Wi-fi is only available in the corridors and common areas, while in your rooms you will need to connect your Ethernet cable to the wall. You should therefore bring an Ethernet cable and your computer if you want a reliable internet connection directly in your rooms.

What will happen when I arrive?

Your arrival is at 10:55pm at Marco Polo Airport; pickup with our colleague Marianna. She will accompany you to the Alilaguna shuttle boat which will take you almost directly to your Residence. Please see the map for how to then walk to the Residence:



In the morning on <u>Tuesday July 18th, at 8am</u>, she will come to meet you again and bring you to San Sebastiano where you will start classes.

What about public transport (vaporetti & buses)?

You will be given a week-long pass for the vaporetti (water boats) upon arrival. The pass makes it easier for you to get to the classrooms or to reach any part of the city but you can of course choose to walk! You must keep it on you at all times in case someone checks it; if you don't you can be fined on the spot!

Where is the classroom?

The classroom is "**Aula 12**" at San Sebastiano. You can see where it is relative to the residence on the map below.

How can I get to class?

The easiest way is on the vaporetto (see the route on the map above). You take boat (<u>Linea 5.1</u>) from Fondamenta Nuove "C" stop and take it all the way around to "San Basilio" (takes 39 minutes); see map. The boat that takes the return trip is called <u>Linea 5.2</u>. From there you go STRAIGHT ahead, and take the SECOND bridge on the left into "Campo San Sebastiano". Our School's office, and the classroom, is right there.
